There are still unanswered questions that may cause some concern but the commitment we have always had at ACS is to the provision of a healthy, safe and productive learning environment, acting as good stewards of this community's investments. Further, a second priority is timely communication. Arizona Charter Schools will continue to use its emergency notification system, its website, school websites, phone calls with district officials and verified district and school social media accounts to best get information out.

Note that if a walkout would transpire after a school day begins, we will make sure all students are supervised until an authorized parent or guardian can pick them up or until the end of the school day when they would return home at their normal time. If the closures last longer than a day, daily communication will continue to be provided.

We are planning for all potential scenarios in order to minimize any potential disruption to your child's education. As always, future plans will be developed with student well-being and safety as our continued top priority!
