RE-ENROLL NOW FOR 2023-2024

Re-enrollment for the 2023-2024 school year will be open soon on our website. New students for next year can start their enrollment now.

SNOW DAYS

We have now exceeded our 3 built in snow days, and will need to use our make-up days in April. At this time, we WILL be in session on April 21 for a half day, and April 24 for a normal school day. Please call if you have any questions.

WINTER CLOTHING

All students must have a winter jacket during this time of year. Please do not send your students to school without a winter coat. Sweatshirts and hoodies are not enough to keep warm during our cold mornings. Jackets can be any color/pattern as they will be worn outside of the classroom only. If you need help getting a winter coat for your students, please call the front office. Snow boots are required only if there is snow on the playground; otherwise, normal footwear is fine.

DRESS CODE REMINDER

We require students to adhere to our uniform dress code. Solid-color polo shirts in the school colors—red (not maroon), white, or navy blue—are acceptable, as are Heritage polo shirts which are available in the office for \$12 each. Slacks, shorts, jumpers, capri pants, and skirts in khaki or navy blue can be worn, but no other "bottom" colors are permitted. Uniforms should not be either excessively baggy or too tight.

TAX CREDITS

You can donate up to \$200 for a single person, or \$400 for a joint return, to Heritage and get a school tax credit on your 2022 Arizona state taxes. Arizona law allows taxpayers to receive a tax credit for donations that benefit our students. A tax credit reduces what you owe in state taxes, dollar-for-dollar.
