PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES

ARIZONA STATE TESTING

Arizona State testing for ELA and Math for grades 3-8 will start on April 1 and will continue until April 26. We're certain our students will all get great scores! Here are some testing tips for students to keep in mind when taking the state tests:

- Read through each question thoroughly

FOCUS ON ATTENDANCE

Excellent attendance is one of the most important aspects of being a good student. Arizona state law states that absences are excessive when they are over 10% of the school year days. Our school year is 180 days, so no student should have over 18 absences for the entire school year. That would be a violation of the state law. Many of our students are already over 18 days of absences. Please make excellent attendance a priority for all our students!
